Santa Monica High School Choir CONCERT ATTIRE

Proper concert attire is formal attire. The concert stage is not the place to make a personal fashion statement. It is the place where we come together as a group to perform. We should appear polished and professional. Nothing should be worn that distracts the audience from the enjoyment of the sounds we produce. For this reason, the following standards have been established and will be strictly enforced. Not adhering to these standards will result in removal from the performance without the opportunity to make up the grade.

Women's Chorus Chorale Women	Classic long black concert dress that will be provided by the choral program. (See the enclosed form for information about obtaining the dress.) Black character shoes. Hair must be in a bun or other "up-do" and out of the eyes. No ponytails. No jewelry.
Madrigal Women Chamber Singers	Dark blue velvet concert dress. (See the enclosed form for information about obtaining the dress). Black character shoes. Hair must be in a bun or other "up-do" and out of the eyes. No ponytails. No jewelry unless uniform jewelry is selected for all women in the upper choirs.
Men's Chorus	Black suit, or black slacks and black dress jacket, or black tuxedo (information about renting a tuxedo from an outside agency is enclosed), white dress shirt, black bow tie, black dress shoes and black socks.
Chorale Men	Black tuxedo (information about renting tuxedos from an outside agency is enclosed), white tux shirt, black bow tie, black dress shoes, black socks.
Madrigal Men	Black tuxedo (information about renting tuxedos from an outside agency is enclosed), white tux shirt, black dress shoes, black socks. Madrigal men also wear a blue vest and blue bow tie that are provided by the choral program.
All	It is suggested, but not required, that students have a choir t-shirt for less formal appearances.
	Since all performance attire looks the same, please label all performance attire with the student's name on removable labels, in case they are misplaced or mixed up.

If for any reason concert attire or supplies present a financial burden, please email or arrange a confidential meeting with Mr. Huls, your house principal or house adviser so that we can provide you with all necessary items. No one will ever be excluded from participating for these reasons.
